Approx. Size: 6 x 6 inches (15 x 15 cm)







Assembly Instructions:

- Decide on a colour scheme for your Bat quilt and start covering the paper pieces with the fabric of your choice (for paper piecing instructions check out the 'Resources' pages on our website):
 - Cover the Large Triangle, the 2 Medium sized and 2 of the Small Triangles and 2 Small Squares with the background fabric (Orange)
 - Cover the remaining pieces with Black Fabric




- Now stitch the 2 Small Orange Triangles to 2 Small Black Triangles (making 2 Squares)
- Next stitch the 2 Small Orange Squares to each the Half-coloured Squares as shown (then put aside)
- Next stitch the remaining 2 Small Black Squares to the 2 Medium sized Orange Triangles as shown:
- Now stitch the remaining Small Orange Triangle to unit A (or B, it doesn't really matter which one) and make that unit into a large triangle as show (then put aside)
- Next stitch the remaining Large Black and Orange Squares into a larger Square, as shown (and set aside)

- Next stitch 2 of the Large Black Squares to the rectangle units made earlier (as shown)
- Next stitch the Triangle Unit (A) made earlier to the LEFT 'Bat-wing' and Unit B to the RIGHT 'Bat-wing' (as shown)



Now you can assemble these pieces into your Bat block! 😊
